- Recruit, train and shepherd volunteer youth staff with diverse gifts and personalities.
- Seek to integrate youth ministry into all phases of church life to create a culture that is intentionally intergenerational, striving to complement our other ministries.
- Plan, organize, and lead summer camp and mission trip experiences for our youth.
- Connect with the life of the church by attending worship, investing in relationships, and pursuing opportunities for personal growth and development.

- A high-energy leader who has a heart and passion for youth ministry in addition to equipping parents and volunteers.
- A strong understanding of the dynamics of youth ministry, culture, and technology.
